

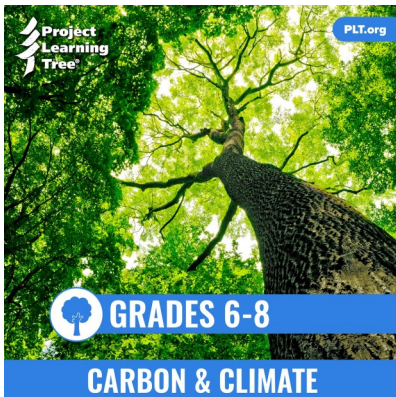


Maryland Association for Environmental and Outdoor Education (MAEOE) Fall Programing, 2017

The Maryland Association for Environmental and Outdoor Education (MAEOE) is offering workshops throughout the fall. Below are the workshop descriptions. Please note these sessions do count towards Green School Application Objective 1.2, 10% of School Staff have Environmental Education Professional Development.

The Project Learning Tree Carbon and Climate E-Unit provides activities and resources to help educators and their students explore some of the complex issues involved in Earth's changing climate. The introduction section was created to help teachers integrate this unit into their existing curricula. Each part of the unit contains:

- detailed step-by-step lesson plans
- downloadable student pages to guide learning
- a range of assessment tools, including pre and post assessments and evaluation rubrics
- easy-to-understand teacher background information
- comprehensive, interactive connections to academic standards
- suggestions for fiction and non-fiction books to enhance the activities
- links to websites, videos, and other supplementary resources
