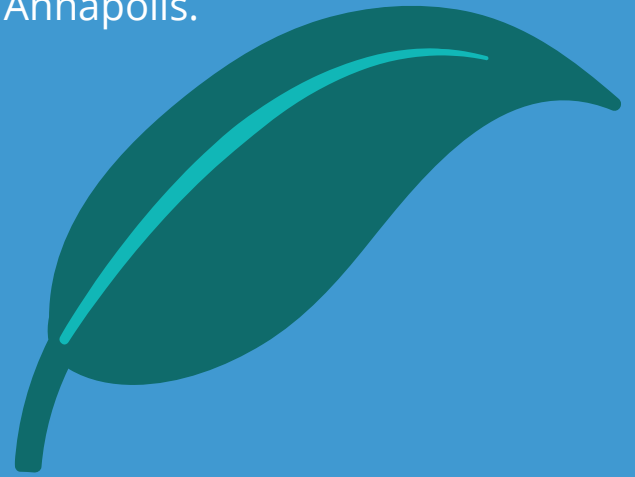


Why Volunteer at SERC?
