- Data Entry Execute a variety of data and donation administration processes
 - Input donations accurately into Salesforce CRM (daily)
 - Assure integrity of database records, deleting duplicate records, appropriate coding, etc.
 - Prepare segmented lists for print mailings and social media communications
- Membership Support Assist with acknowledgement letters and emails, ensure timely adherence to gift acknowledgement procedures
- Events Coordination assist with logistics and planning for fundraising events, including an annual Benefit Gala, tabling at outreach events and following up with prospective members
- Graphics Design for fundraising materials including appeal letters, brochures, event signage, infographics, and visual storytelling
- Other duties, as assigned
